To help keep our community safe, please also ensure that garbage is properly secured and avoid leaving food sources outdoors. Pet owners are encouraged to keep cats and other indoor pets from roaming freely, as roaming pets can attract predators and may be at risk from wildlife.

## Protect Our Sewer System – Only Flush the “3 P’s”

We would like to remind residents that only the 3 Ps should be flushed down the toilet: **Pee, Poo, and toilet Paper.**

Items such as paper towels, disinfectant wipes (even those labeled “flushable”), feminine hygiene products, diapers, cotton swabs, dental floss, grease, and other household waste should never be flushed. These materials do not break down properly in the sewer system and can cause significant blockages, equipment damage, and sewer backups.

When inappropriate items are flushed, they can clog municipal pumps and infrastructure, resulting in **costly repairs** and increased maintenance. These unexpected expenses place added pressure on the municipal budget and, if the issue continues, may ultimately impact **utility rates or tax rates**.
